WHAT ARE EVERY CHILD READY TO READ WORKSHOPS?

These workshops are an early literacy opportunity for parents and caregivers. Attendees will learn why it's important for children to get ready to read starting from birth, and the essential role parents and other caregivers have in developing early literacy skills. Parents and caregivers, along with their children, will engage in talking, singing, reading, writing, and play activities that help develop early literacy skills.

WHAT IS PLAY AND LEARN?

Play and Learn is for families with young children (ages 0-4). We provide toys and a fun group environment while a local early childhood expert takes time with each family to share tips. Parents can attend more than one Play and Learn to connect with different early childhood professionals (e.g. early literacy, nutritionist, pediatrician, etc.) about questions or concerns they might have. This program helps parents increase their awareness of local resources related to early childhood and early literacy.
